

TRY OUT THIS FUN FALL RECIPE: CROCK POT CHEESY POTATO SOUP

Ingredients:

- 6 large peeled Yukon Gold potatoes cut in 1/2 -inch cubes
- 1 medium onion (diced)
- 3 cloves garlic (minced)
- 1 teaspoons salt
- 1 teaspoon pepper
- 4-6 cups cups chicken broth
- 1 cup cold milk
- 3 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- ½ cup heavy cream or half and half
- 1 pound Velveeta Cheese (cut into chunks)
- Bacon fried and crumbled, (optional)
- green onions (optional)



STEPS:

- 1. Add the potatoes, onion, garlic, salt, pepper and the chicken broth to a 4 quart or larger crock pot, stir and cook on high for about 3 ½ hours.
- 2. Whisk the 3 tablespoons of flour into the 1 cup of cold milk until smooth. Stir the flour mixture into the potatoes, add the ½ cup heavy cream, stir then cover and cook for another 30 minutes or until potatoes are tender.
- 3. Add the chunks of cheese and allow to melt. Garnish with bacon and green onions.
