WI-THETA RAISES THE BAR AT CHICAGO CARLSON LEADERSHIP ACADEMY

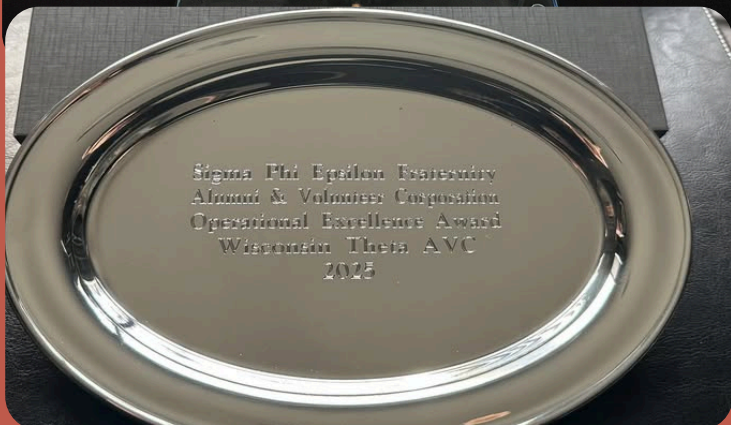
Back in February, ten undergraduate brothers, including seven of the new executive board, traveled to Chicago to attend SigEp's Carlson Leadership Academy (CLA).

The Brothers had opportunities to attend specific leadership tracks that were tailored to each of their executive board positions, as well as connect with brothers from other chapters in those same positions!



At the end of the weekend, the undergraduate chapter was recognized for their excellent Balanced Man Programming by receiving a 2nd consecutive McCleary Award for Excellence in Member Development.

The AVC was also recognized for another exceptional year by receiving a 2nd consecutive Operational Excellence Award.



BROTHER TY MEYER BECOMES FIRST WI-THETA TRAGOS SCHOLAR!

The Tragos Quest to Greece is a prestigious study abroad program where SigEp brothers travel to various Greek historical sites and explore Greek history and culture, while reflecting upon the origins of SigEp's values and the Balanced Man Ideal.

Every year hundreds of applicants apply to be selected for this program, and each year around 18-20 undergraduates are selected from all SigEp chapters.

Brother Ty Meyer becomes the first WI-Theta to be selected to attend this experience!



Q: What does it mean to you to study leadership in Greece?

Ty: SigEp is founded on Greek principles. While we talk about ideals in our ceremonies, we rarely actually talk about the Greek background. Overall, I think Tragos will help me understand the fraternal tie to GREEK life.

Q: Are there any concepts you're especially excited to learn about or just anything in general?

Ty: I'm excited to travel abroad for the first time and get to experience new cultures surrounded by brothers!

Q: What do you hope this experience teaches you about yourself?

Fun Fact: The distal interphalangeal joint in Joel's left middle toe is fused!

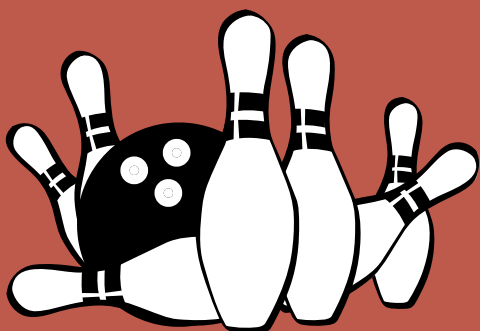
WI-THETA CONNECTIONS WEEKEND

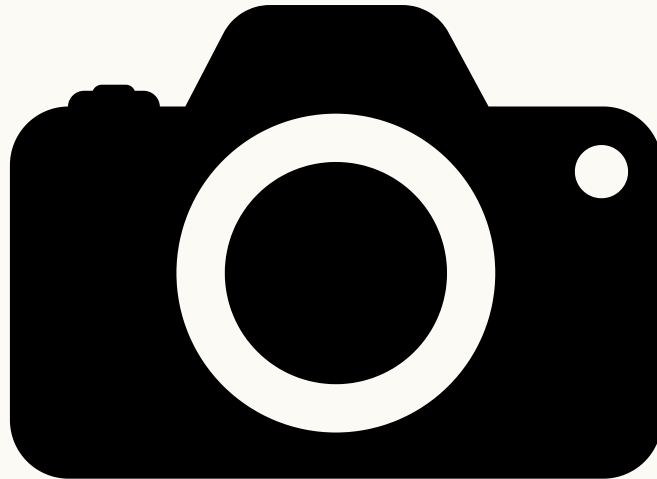
